V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

VIIa. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

Please note the following clarifications for the corresponding item numbers in the above **Section VII. FEE SCHEDULE**:

- Mobile Home Unit Site: When an item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.
- Fixtures, Floor Drains, Special Drains & Water Connected Appliances **include, but are not limited to**, the following:

- Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If it is determined by the inspector that a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in #4 for \$5.00 each, and the appropriate water distribution pipe system size fee.
- Medical Gas Systems shall include the application fee, one Special/Safety Inspection – Medical Gas Systems, and the estimated number of additional inspections in #23.

VIII. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Items, quantities and inspections that are overlooked, unforeseen, or omitted from the original permit application will be billed to the permit holder. These additional fees must be paid prior to a final inspection being conducted. Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been approved by Grant Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected and approved. To schedule an inspection, contact the Plumbing Inspector a minimum of 24 hours prior and be ready to provide the property address, permit number and type of inspection requested.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months of the permit being issued or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after work has commenced. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE ISSUE DATE OR WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THE LAST INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
