Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

V. APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Code Act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subjected to civil fines.

VIII. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Provide all information required in items 1-7, paying special attention to items 5-6. Items, quantities and inspections that are overlooked, unforeseen, or omitted from the original permit application will be billed to the permit holder. These additional fees must be paid prior to a final inspection being conducted. Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been approved by Grant Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected and approved. To schedule an inspection, contact the Electrical Inspector a minimum of 24 hours prior and be ready to provide the property address, permit number and type of inspection requested.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months of the permit being issued or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after work has commenced. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE ISSUE DATE OR WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THE LAST INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS WILL NOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
