TAX NEWS

<u>2016 Winter Property Taxes</u> will be mailed out by the end of November, Tuesday, February 14, 2017 is the due date. The township hall will be open for residents paying in person. Those paying in cash at any time are requested to *PLEASE* bring correct change.

Please review the information on your bill as soon as you receive it and call us right away if you feel that something is not correct.

The <u>December Board of Review</u> is scheduled for Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. to correct any clerical errors, PRE or Ag Exemption appeals or Hardship appeals.

2nd Home Exemptions are available for property owners who are unable to sell their old home once they have moved into a new one. This allows the homeowner to retain the PRE on both homes. The first home, however, must remain unoccupied while it is for sale. This exemption can be renewed for up to two additional years. Contact the Assessor for details or questions.

<u>Dog Licenses</u> are NO LONGER available for purchase at the Township. Licenses can be obtained by mail, most veterinarian offices and several physical locations throughout the county (see www.dogs.stclaircounty.org) beginning December 1st. On-line purchasing will be available on January 1st at www.dogs.stclaircounty.org.

BOARD OF REVIEW-TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13TH-9 A.M.

The December Board of Review meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, December 13^h at 9 am. The purpose is to hear PRE or Ag Exemption appeals, correct clerical errors and hear any Hardship appeals. Anyone wishing to apply for a Hardship Exemption can get a copy of the application from the Township Hall. When completed the application must be returned with a copy of your 2015 Income Tax form or other proof of income. Everyone who lives in the home must be included on the form as well as any income from their individual jobs. If you have not received the Principal Residence Exemption or the Agricultural Exemption and you feel you should have received it you can appeal to the Board of Review. Copies of your Record Card showing how your assessment was arrived at can be picked up at the Township Hall.

The Principal Residence Exemption deadline has been changed from the May 1st deadline to June 1st for the summer tax bill and November 1st for the December tax bill. If your school district levies the school operating taxes on the summer tax bill then filing after June 1st will not give you the exemption for the current year. If you have any questions I am in the Township Hall on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month.
